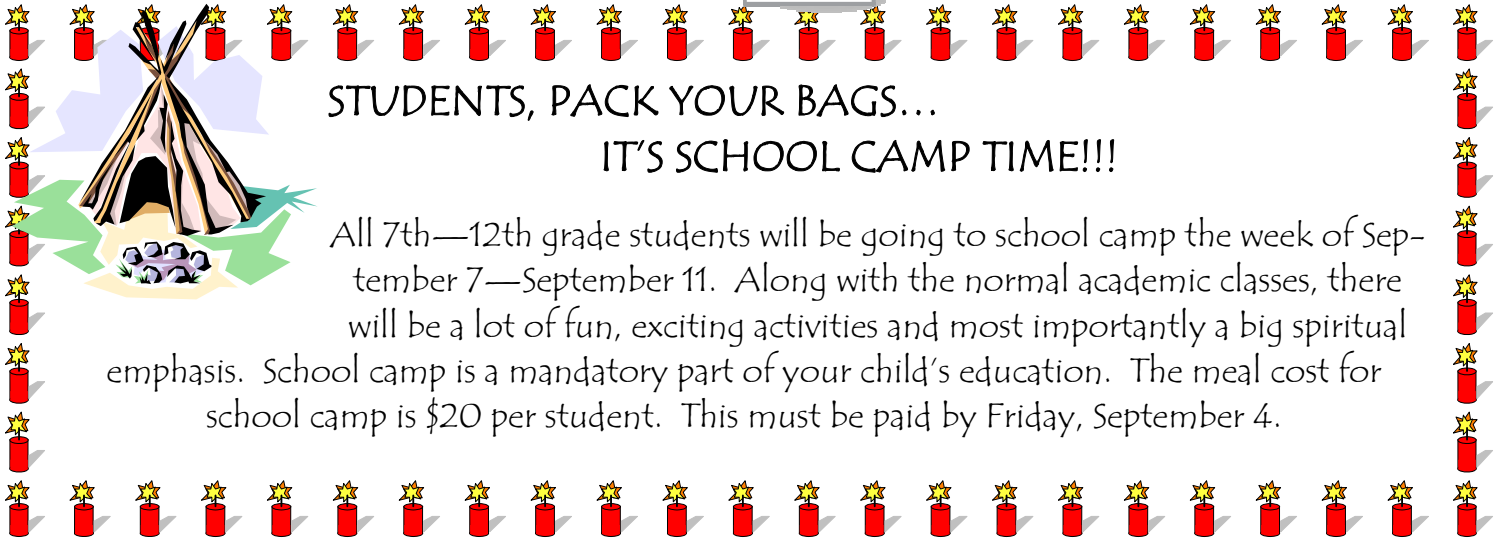

PARENTS OF EIGHTH GRADERS, THIS IS IMPORTANT FOR YOU TO KNOW.



The \$87.50 tuition for the month of September is due on September 15.

In order for your eighth grader to pass the eighth grade, his reading ability must be in the 30 percentile or higher of the national average. All eighth graders are in reading classes and are tested periodically throughout the school year. It helps the students when they read at home as well as at school.

DRESS CODE POLICIES FOR THE GIRLS

The girls are doing an excellent job with dress this year. Every 6th—12th grade girl must attend dress check between 8:00—8:25 a.m. every morning. If the student is not in dress code and the offence cannot be corrected, the girl must go home or spend the day in the cafeteria. This is an unexcused absence. Listed below is our dress code/check policy for the school year.

1st and 2nd Offense	The girl must fix the problem. She receives ten Demerits, and she may return to class.
3rd Offense	A letter is sent home as well as a call to the parents.
4th Offense	Student receives a one day suspension and a phone call is made to the parents.
5th Offense	The student may not return to school until her parents have met with a school official. After this, she receives an automatic one day suspension for any dress code infraction.
